- Doug Sheppard, Superintendent Delta School District.

Doug: secondary cross-curricular discussion at Seaquam; student report template piloting and feedback; court case between BCTF and BC government still going – more teachers and more transfers among schools/districts, announcement of funding; snow/weather closure – try to stay open as much as possible, data gathering 5:00 – 5:30AM, try to make decision by 6:00 AM, may close part of district, up to parent to decide if to send kids to school, principal supposed to be at school even school closes, Delta schools are capable of handling heavy snows (about 3 times of this years snowfall);

Delta School District Budget Process & Current Realities:

- uncertainties: funding for 2017/18 not announced until mid-March; Supreme Court decision not know; Prov election in May;

- 89% funding from Ministry of Edppou; 6% from International fees

- Ministry announcement of Delta funding: Mar 15; public release of budget

recommendation: April 14; adoption of budget, April 25



- School district cannot incur deficit; if not enough funding, then cut ongoing costs, use prior year reserve funds

- Reserve funds: main sources: International program fees, Ministry holdback; are of onetime nature; main uses: help balancing budget, unusual expenses and one tie projects, carry-forward funds, ..

- District budget guidelines: service levels will not increase, expanded service funded through discontinued initiatives, teaching staff & EA's decided by enrollment, ...

- budget composition: mainly teacher salary

- Student Learning Grant: Delta \$750,000,
